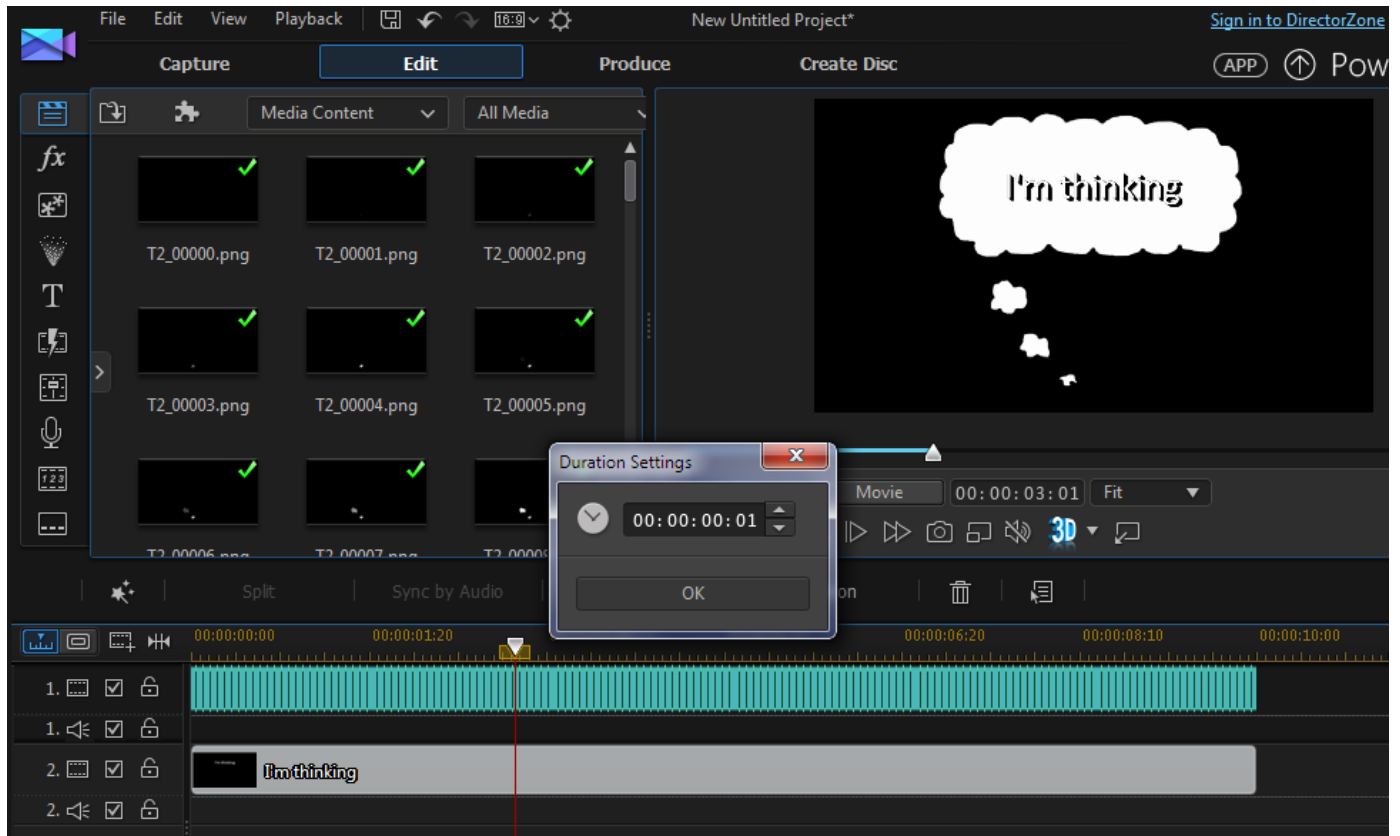


# Swapping Animation Files in Title Templates

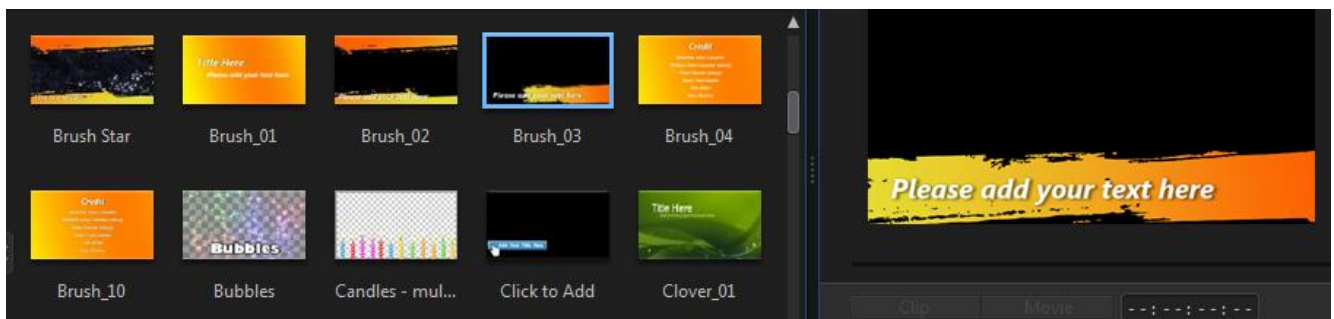
To make a **title** with **graphic animation** in PowerDirector, the animation files can be inserted in a separate track from the title, with all animation files set at a 1-2 frame duration



To build the animation into a **title template** for future use, the animation files must be swapped into an existing PDR template.

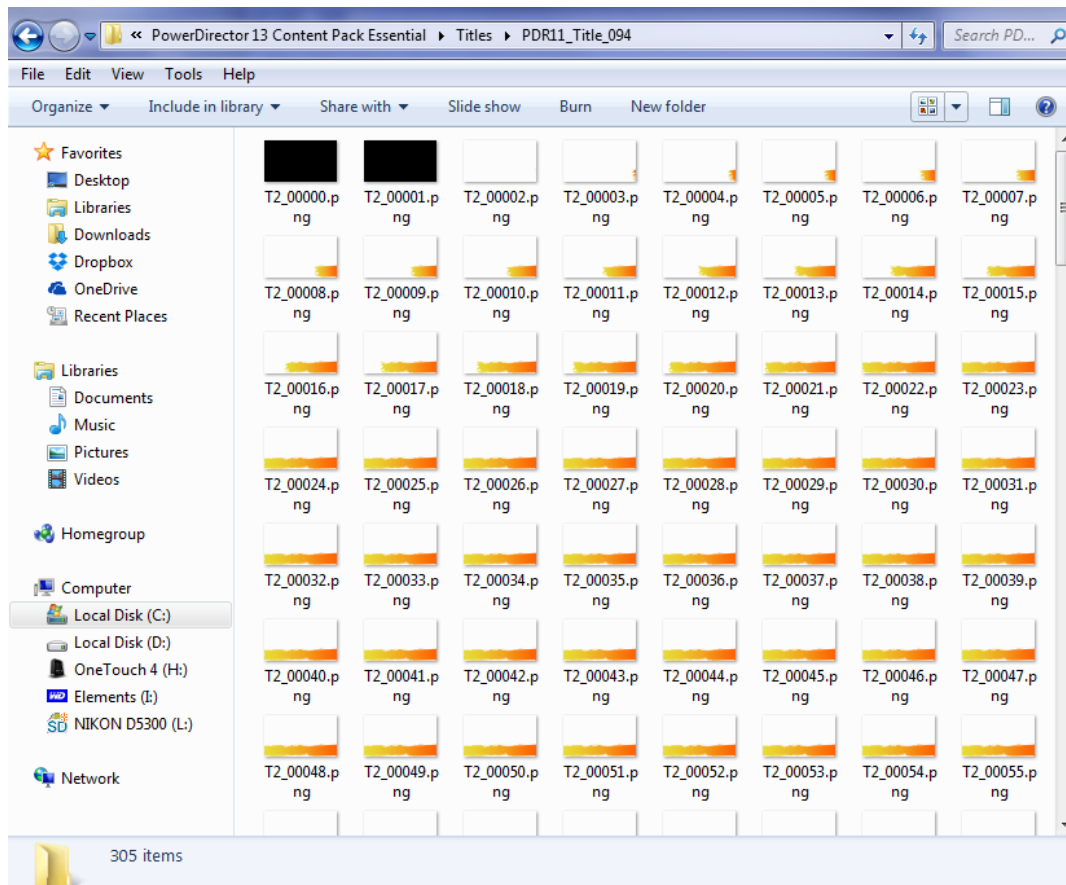
The title template folders (with built in animation) contain separate animation files – up to 300

To illustrate, we'll start with the "Brush\_03" template & modify the animation...



The template folder is found at **C:\Program Files (x86)\CyberLink\Templates\PowerDirector Content Pack 13\PowerDirector 13 Content Pack Essential\Titles\PDR11\_Title\_094**

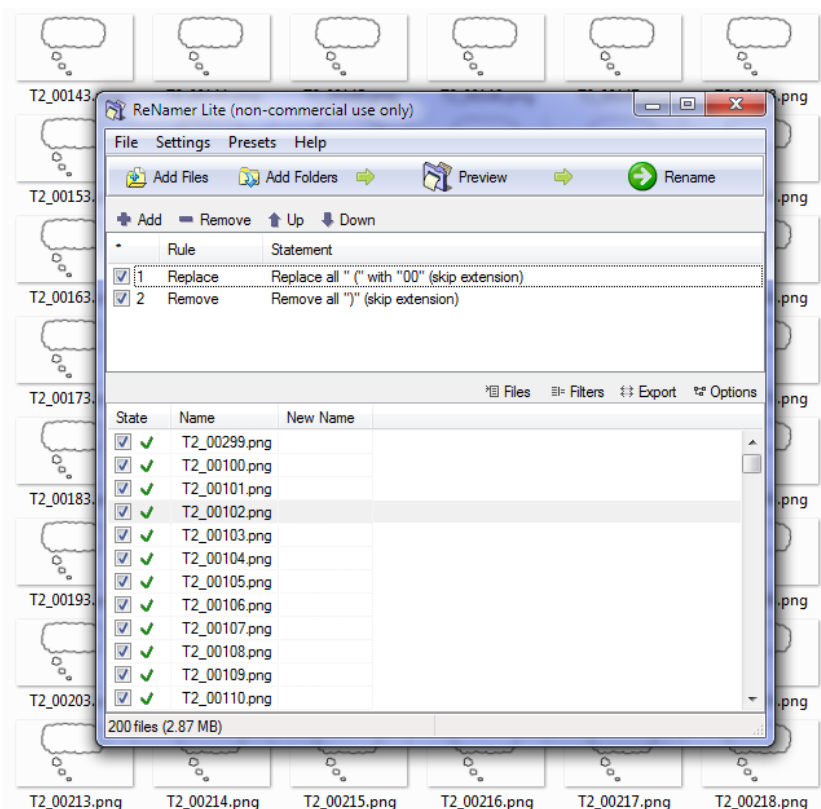
It contains 300 animation files (.png) which we'll swap.



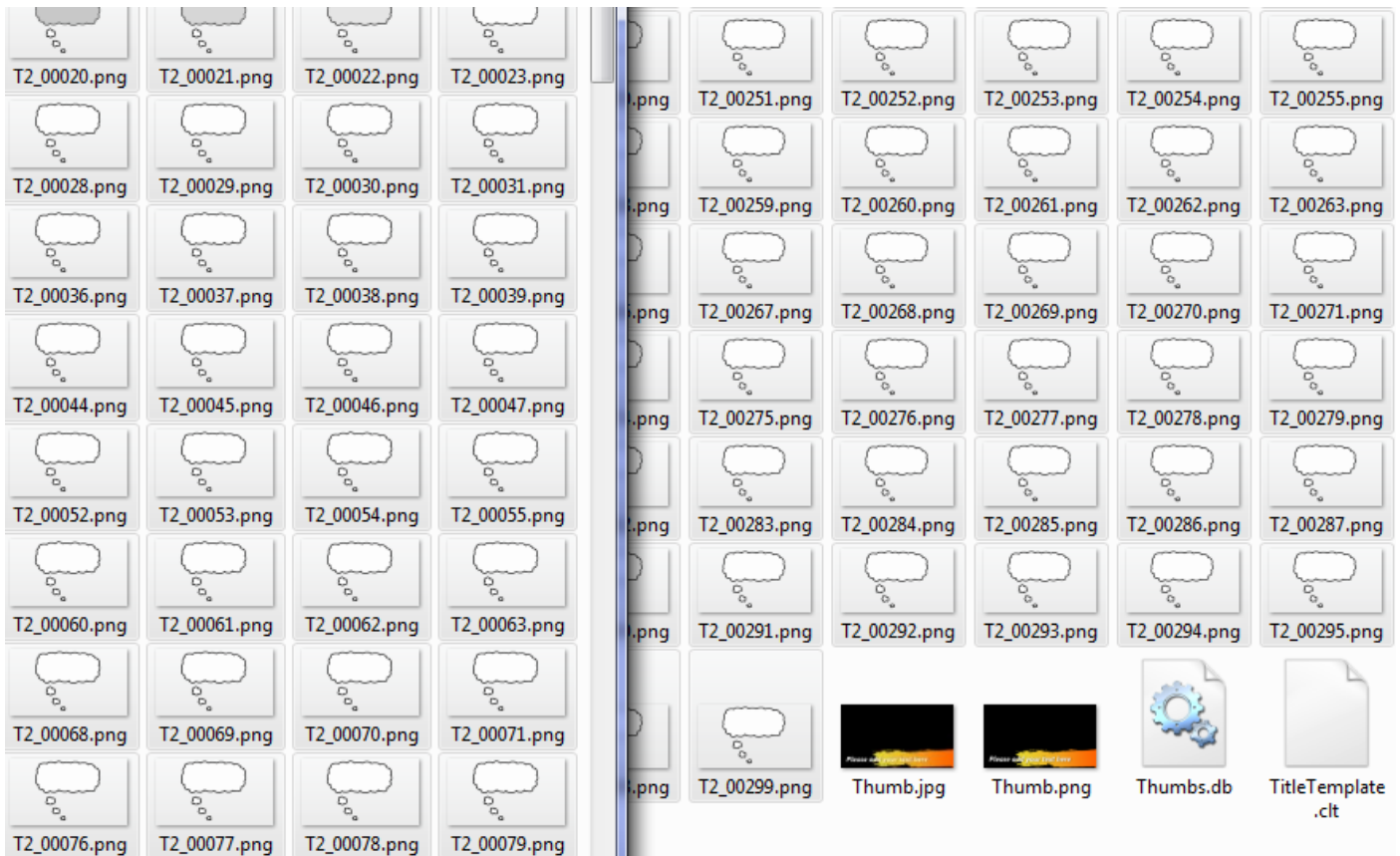
► **Step 1** – make a backup copy of the whole folder, to replace later

► **Step 2** – create the animation files needed. There should be 300 files, even if some are duplicates & they need to be resized to 640x360 (not critical). The files **MUST** be renamed to be consistent with the template folder... T2\_00000, T2\_00001.... T2\_00299

Renaming software can be used to facilitate this



► **Step 3** – after the animation files are prepared, copy & paste them into the selected template folder



► **Step 4** – Close the folder and open PDR, then open the Title Room

► **Step 5** – Locate “Brush\_03” (which now contains the new animation files)

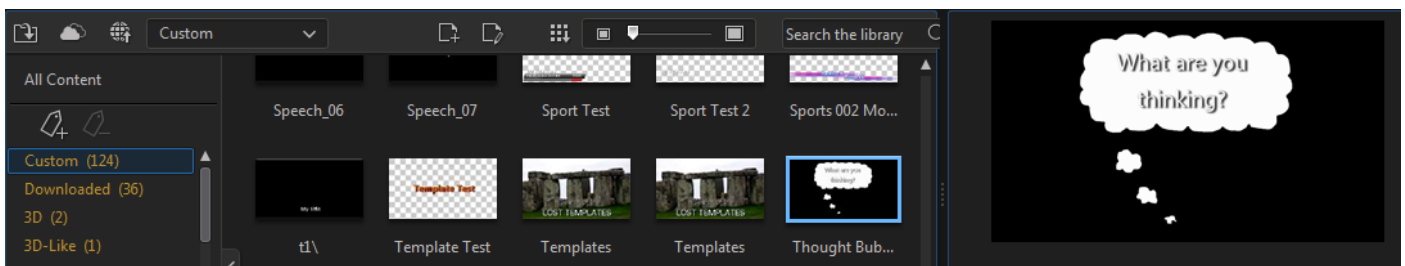
► **Step 6** – Right click “Brush\_03” & select Modify

► **Step 7** – Adjust the text to match the new animation by resizing & repositioning

► **Step 8** – Save As a new template & close PDR

► **Step 9** – Re-open the folder **C:\Program Files (x86)\CyberLink\Templates\PowerDirector Content Pack 13\PowerDirector 13 Content Pack Essential\Titles** and replace the modified PDR11\_Title\_094 folder with the original (backup copy made in Step 1)

If all steps have been followed correctly, Brush\_03 will be restored to its original state and the new template will be available in the Title Room under **Custom**
