

# Norse Trackmen Win

Northeastern A&M defeated Connors of Warner, 84 to 48, in a dual track and field Robertson Field.

Busiest performer for Coach Jack Rucker's Norsemen was Ed Turlington, freshman from Satellite Beach, Fla. He anchored the winning 440, 880 and mile relay foursome, placed second in the 100 dash and third in the 220 dash.

The 100 dash, into the wind, was won by Gary Deaton of Connors in 10.1. Deaton and Randy Scott of the Norse tied for first in the 220 at 23.8.

Double winners for the Norse included George Gibbs, 5:05.2 in the mile and 11:20 in the two-mile run, and Guy Owen, 5:11 for the high jump and 112:11 in the discus throw.
