
Imported GIF directly into **new PD18 pds** (i.e. blank), 60 fps



PD18: Properties in **Library**






PD18: Properties in **Timeline**




>>> GIF **actually** runs for 4:48 in **PD18** at 10 fps

GIF **actually** runs for 1:55 in PD21 at 25 fps

SUMMARY

1. Both PD18 and PD21 had **Timeline Frame Rate = 60 fps** and Aspect Ratio = 1:1
2. Entire GIF file runs for 00:00:04:48 in **PD18** at 10 fps
3. Same GIF file runs for only 00:00:01:55 in **PD21** at 25 fps

Question: Why do the different versions import the same GIF at **different Frame Rates**?
